
**Condensing Osteitis** 

36 y.o. female with right knee pain for 1 month began since squatting. No trauma/injury.





#### **Another Example**

A five-year-old boy with neck pain, torticollis, and arm pain.

There had been numbness radiating down the forearm into the thumb, index, and long fingers. Computed tomography and MRI revealed a calcified disc herniated into the spinal canal with canal compromise of 60%.
